



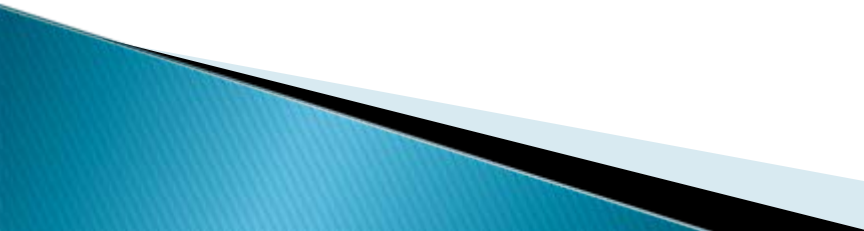
October 1, 1960

- ▶ This first Kansas State Assembly was held in Manhattan, Kansas
 - ▶ Out of the 27 registered groups, 9 Group Representatives were present. These included Kansas City, Topeka, Overland Park, Wichita, Colby, and Beloit.
 - ▶ There were 6 districts.

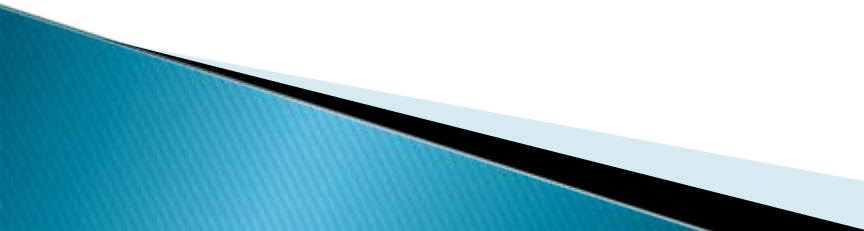
More History from that first Assembly Oct 1, 1960

- ▶ Evona H. was elected Delegate and Millie R. was elected State Chairman.
 - ▶ Balance on hand was \$71.63
- 

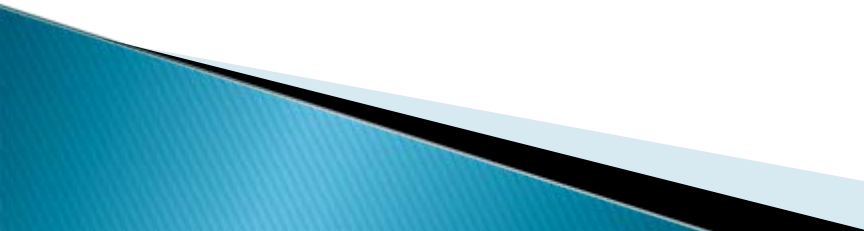
More History – 1960's

- ▶ The Assembly traveled around the state – Newton, Great Bend, Wichita, Scott City, Beloit, Greensburg, etc.
 - ▶ 1962 – Alateens were given a vote at Assembly.
 - ▶ 1965 – It was voted that Assemblies would be the 3rd weekend in January and second weekend in June.

More History – 1960's

- ▶ 1964 – the Suggested Preamble was read for the first time in a Kansas State meeting at the State Committee meeting.
 - ▶ 1966 – Our newsletter was given the name “Stepfinder”.
 - ▶ 1968 – it costs \$250 to send a delegate to WSC plus \$50 for incidentals.
 - ▶ 1969 – a special fund was set up to buy a mimeograph machine.

More History – 1970's

- ▶ 1970 – PLAN 22 was voted in, changing Kansas from 6 districts to 22 districts.
 - ▶ 1971 – Public Relations Coordinator and Alateen Coordinator positions were created. Pat S. was our first Public Relations Coordinator.
 - ▶ 1973 – the first Kansas Al-Anon/Alateen Conference was held in Topeka, KS
 - ▶ 1976 – there are 25 Alateen groups in Kansas.
 - ▶ 1979 – Group Records Coordinator position added

More History – 1980's

- ▶ 1980 – the first Kansas Alateen Round Up was held in Arkansas City, KS
 - ▶ 1984 – 198 members registered at the November Assembly
 - ▶ 1987 – a motion to start a Reserve Fund passed
 - ▶ 1988 – there were 235 Al-Anon and 44 Alateen groups in Kansas

More History – 1990's

- ▶ 1990 – Kansas Alateen Round Up had 172 in attendance
 - ▶ 1991 – there are 227 Al-Anon groups, 47 Alateen groups, 6 Institutions groups and 6 Lone Members
 - ▶ 1999 – Institutions, PI, and CPC positions were combined into one position: Public Outreach Coordinator

More History – 2000's (?)

- ▶ 2000 – we presented a quilt, signed by members in all Kansas districts, to WSO for the Al-Anon 50th Anniversary
 - ▶ 2003 – Area Webmaster became an Area Coordinator position
